

Way of Council is an art of listening... a moment to breathe... a ceremony

When collectively practiced with clear intent, we can touch the field, open to reflections, see, hear and find ourselves in each other's stories. As we deepen the practice, our interconnectedness becomes more apparent, weaving through our relations, our history and the stories of our ancestors. Our natural environment, past, presence and future are no longer separated as concepts but increasingly embodied by our lives and experiences as living bridges that connect them, our stories the rivers that pass through.

After some practice at holding a circle, getting the feel of a field that encompasses a wide variety of responses and inputs from the human condition, new questions begin to arise. An awareness that we as facilitator are holding an important seat – a seat that has more influence on our councils than perhaps we first imagined. As we deepen into service, our response-ability is equally invited to increase. Sharing our experiences with our peers, mentors and guides becomes a necessary part of our widening the circle; the ripples go out and some return with new challenges, or old ones that wont go away...

And so we sit with each other and listen, share and learn from what is current, what is brought and what we are invited to attend to further our work, vocation and service to the bigger picture, a collective process at times with the potential mirrors from nature, shadow, practice, mindfulness and play.
